As you can see, there are many people to thank for making one of these events come off successfully. If there have been any names omitted from this list, please forgive me and know that you are appreciated.

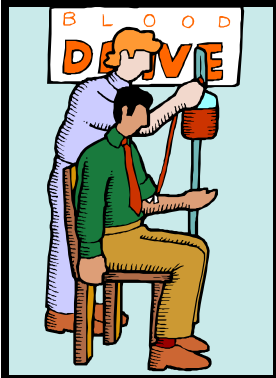
